Bring money for lunch, homemade ice cream and a quick visit to the shops in Estes on the way home. Fee is \$35 and priority goes to Active Duty and dependents.

April 8 - National Beer Day On April 7, 1933, President Franklin Roosevelt took the first step toward ending Prohibition and signed a law that allowed people to brew and sell beer, in the United States. (We are celebrating a day late). One of the world's oldest prepared beverages, beer possibly dates back to 9500 BC when cereal was first farmed. It is recorded in the written history of ancient Iraq and ancient Egypt. Beer is the world's most widely consumed alcoholic beverage. Following water and tea, it is the third most popular drink overall. Join us for a few select breweries in the Denver Beer Triangle for only \$15.

April 9 - Rocky Mountain Hiking Trip (Weather Permitting) Over 415 square miles of protected mountain terrain with a huge network of hiking trails & wildlife. Start getting in hiking shape! As you plan your hike, keep in mind that park elevations range from 7,500 to over 12,000 feet. Even very fit individuals coming from lower elevations may experience altitude problems. April 22 - Genesee Experiential Challenge Course The Genesee Challenge Course is set in a beautiful stand of Ponderosa Pines overlooking the continental divide. There are roughly 60 low and high elements that creates a program specifically designed to achieve your group's goals. Ropes course advocates claim that they meet a number of educational, developmental, and recreational goals. High ropes course and climbing programs generally focus on personal achievements and ask participants to confront their personal fears and anxieties. Challenges may be physical and/or emotional. In certain cases, high element programs involve the development and mastery of technical skills to manage rope belay systems used to secure other

climbers as they move through the course. In such cases, outcomes often include exploring the fundamentals of trust, craftsmanship, and coaching. Programs using low ropes course elements or group initiatives are most often designed to explore group interaction, problem-solving, and leadership. Some of the commonly claimed outcomes include enhancement of cooperation, decision making, self-confidence, positive risk taking, social cohesion, trust, self-esteem, leadership, goal setting, and teamwork. Cost is \$10 per person.

April 27 - 30 - Moab Adventure Moab has some of the most interesting and unique terrain of any mountain biking destination. The riding here tends to lean towards challenging to extremely challenging with big descents, rocky trails with big technical moves, and many long epic rides to choose from. A classic example is the famous Slickrock trail which is a multiple hour mountain bike ride ENTIRELY on smooth rock that makes you feel as if you're riding on the moon! Explore the beautiful scenery around Arches National Park. Bring your own bike or take one of ours. Priority goes to Single Airmen and Active Duty and spouses. Bring your camera, hiking shoes and bike gear for two solid days of some of the best trails in the country! There are a variety of trails for all skill levels in this area. The biking will be self-guided so bring a friend. Trip includes transportation, park entrance, lodging and some meals. Fee is \$125.




