

Funding

The UNITE CONOPS were approved 24 January 2022. CY22 funding was allocated 22 January 22 and can be used through December 2022. The installation C3 can confirm your allocation which was based on unit strength as of September 2021.

CY21 Allocations per Person

\$13.50 APF (MOA)

Participation Costs

Activity, supplies, decorations, equipment rentals, etc.

Funds CANNOT be used for prizes.

\$5 NAF

Food Allowance

One meal and one non-alcoholic beverage.

Meal must be used in conjunction with a UNITE event.

UNITE funds CANNOT be used to augment holiday parties on or off the installation. Units are responsible for expenses that exceed the allotted amount. UNITE funds CANNOT be combined with Unit Enhancement Funds or SM&W Funds.

Private Org funds may be used.

Paying for UNITE

Your installation C3 will make UNITE payments on your behalf via a purchasing card or a TBCC, though you must ensure budget limits are maintained at all times. Final attendance count is due at least 72 hours prior to your ON-BASE event and will be used to invoice meals planned at FSS facilities. If the actual number is greater than what was planned, you'll be invoiced for the greater number. Off-base attendance requirements may differ.

1. Complete the POC Appointment Letter

Squadron Commanders will appoint a squadron Unite POC, in writing, to the FSS UNITE lead coordinator.

2. Event Proposal

Meet with your installation C3 to discuss your objectives, event ideas, and to complete the "Event Proposal Form". Event approval may take up to 30 days. The form is available at <https://www.funatwarren.com/unite-program/>

Event proposal must be signed by squadron/unit commander.

3. DOD ID#'s

DoD ID Numbers are requested in order to send participants online surveys after the event in efforts to examine the correlation between participation in FSS programs, services and activities and Airmen & Unit Readiness.

The UNITE Program was developed to provide squadron leaders with the maximum flexibility to deliver programs that build cohesion for personnel within their unit. This includes assigned Active Duty and both APF and NAF Civilians. Family members are welcome to participate, but they must pay any associated fees.



Types of Events

1. Ready to Execute (RTE)

RTE programs are pre-approved and easy to implement. FSS related events keep funds on the installation and should be considered first.

2. Unit Developed Program (UDP)

Squadron leaders are given the discretion to create UDPs that capitalize on opportunities available in the local area. UDPs require prior approval through the Air Force Services Activity (AFSVA) and may take up to 30 days.

3. Free/Volunteer

Charitable work provides a cost effect team building activity that allows co-workers to see each other in a new light and can make a real difference in your community. Free events do not need approval, but we still need to capture the information.
